**CLARRIFICATIONS TO ISSUES RAISED IN PROOF OF EVIDENCE OF MICHAEL
FRASER**

1 Introduction

- 1.1 This note provides a record of minor clarifications regarding the text of the Proof of Evidence of Michael Fraser [CRCL/P/9/A] and the Appendices [CRCL/P/9/B]. The issues do not substantially affect the information in the documents, but this note provides a record of answers to questions that have been given in evidence or which have been given during discussions with objectors, which do not appear in the Erratum to the Proof of Evidence of Michael Fraser [CRCL/P/D] but which provide clarification to the reader.

2 Clarifications Referring to Main Proof of Evidence of Michael Fraser

- 2.1 Page 21, 3.12, fifth line remove “refined”. The modelling in Table 12 is based on the modelling techniques in the ES.
- 2.2 Page 26, title of Table 13, to read” Phase 1 and Phase 2” of the scheme. The modelling in Table 13 includes the traffic and works from Phase 1, 2a and 2b.
- 2.3 The use of “upper floors” in evidence has led to questions from Mr Napier OBJ 88 regarding which floor is being referred to. To clarify this Page 31, Table 14, 11th row, 6th column should read “No barrier due to visual effects. “ Insulation at first floor only.”
- 2.4 To clarify this Page 32, Table 14, 15th row, 6th column should read “Insulation at second floor only.”
- 2.5 To clarify this Page 33, 3.31 Penultimate sentence to refer to “Table 6.19 in the ES [CD/1.16]”.

3 Clarifications Referring to Appendices to Proof of Evidence of Michael Fraser

- 3.1 Appendix MF 2, Page MF2-1, 2.3 last sentence to read “ in Table 2.1 and 2.2”.
- 3.2 Appendix MF 3, Page MF3-2, 3.12 3rd and 4th lines by “second storey” it was intended to refer to 2nd floor level. The reference in the 5th line to “basement level” was intended to indicate “ground floor level”. Quadrangle House consists of three floors, the ground floor of which is a car parking area, and the first and second floors are flats. References to “2nd Storey” in Table 3.1 and 3.2 should also refer to “2nd floor”, and references to the “basement” should refer to “ground floor”.
